Here's what I learnt after those sleepless nights in the garage:

### **The Pivot**

You cannot "hustle" your way out of a broken system.

The answer is the **“CEO Exit Strategy.”**

Here's how it works.

### **1] Hire a 'team'**

Is a minute you aren't actually making moves.

Hiring a team isn't about being a "boss."

## 3] Centralize your operations

The key is to build a 'Centralized Knowledge Base'.

Store it in a vault.
